AMENDMENT OF THE BYLAWS AS APPROVED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF MARYLAND MUTUAL NO. ELEVEN, INC.

The following amendments to the Bylaws of Maryland Mutual No. Eleven, Inc., were approved by the unit owners representing 67.27% of the Membership:

AMEND ARTICLE X, SECTION 2, by deleting in its entirety the first sentence and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

It is the policy of this Mutual to provide housing for older persons. Implementation of this policy and other reasonable restrictions on occupancy or residents under 55 years of age in the units of this Mutual shall be governed by rules established by the Board of Directors.

AMEND ARTICLE X, SECTION 4, by deleting paragraph (1) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- (o) To adopt, repeal or amend the rules for the condominium association, the Board of Directors shall:
 - (i) Mail or deliver to each unit owner: (a) a copy of any proposal for the adoption, repeal or amendment of any rule; (b) notice of the proposed effective date of the proposed rule; (c) notice that unit owners are permitted to submit written comments on the proposed rule; (d) notice of the date of an open meeting of the Board, at which a vote will be taken on the proposed rule. Such meeting may not be less than 15 days after the date of the notice sent.
 - (ii) At the open meeting of the Board, at which a quorum of the Board must be present, following consideration of all comments, the Board will vote to adopt the proposal with any modifications it may determine, or to withdraw it.
 - (iii) Each rule adopted under this section (11-111 of the Maryland Condominium Act) shall state that the rule was adopted under the provisions of 11-111 of the Maryland Condominium Act. A rule may not be adopted under said section after July 1, 1984 if the rule is inconsistent with the condominium Declaration or Bylaws.
 - (iv) The Board shall send to all unit owners and lessees a report of its action (except withdrawal), the text of the rule or a summary thereof, and the effective date of the rule.

The following amendment to the Bylaws of Maryland Mutual No. Eleven, Inc., were approved by the unit owners representing 67.27 percent of the Membership:

AMEND SECTION X, ARTICLE 4, by adding a new paragraph (p) Dispute Settlement Mechanism as follows:

(p) The Board of Directors may not impose a fine, suspend voting, or infringe upon any other rights of a unit owner or other occupant for violations of rules until the following procedure is followed:

- (i) Written demand to cease and desist from an alleged violation is served upon the alleged violator specifying:
- (A) The alleged violation;
- (B) The action required to abate the violation; and
- during which the violation may be abated without further sanction, if the violation is a continuing one; or if the violation is not a continuing one, a statement that further violation of the same rule may result in the imposition of sanction after due notice and hearing.
- (ii) Within 12 months of the demand, if the violation continues past the period allowed in the demand for abatement without penalty, or if the same rule is violated subsequently, the Board serves the alleged violator with written notice of a hearing to be held by the Board in session. The notice shall contain:
- (A) The nature of the alleged violation;
- (B) The time and place of the hearing, which time may not be less than 10 days from the giving of the notice;
- (C) An invitation to attend the hearing and produce any statement, evidence, and witnesses on his or her behalf; and
- (D) The proposed sanction to be imposed.
- has the right to present evidence and present and cross-examine witnesses.

 The hearing and cross-examine witnesses.
 The hearing shall be held in executive session pursuant to this notice and shall afford the alleged violator a reasonable opportunity to be heard.

 Prior to the effectiveness of any sanction hereunder, proof of notice and the invitation to be heard shall be deemed adequate if a copy of the notice, together with a statement of the date and manner of delivery, is entered by the officer or director who delivered the notice. The notice requirement shall be deemed satisfied if the alleged violator appears at the meeting. The minutes of the meeting shall contain a written statement of the results of the hearing and the sanction, if any, imposed.
- (iv) A decision pursuant to these procedures shall be appealable to the courts of Maryland.

If any unit owner fails to comply with this title, the declaration, or bylaws, or a decision rendered pursuant to this section, the unit owner may be sued for damages caused by the failure or for injunctive relief, or both, by the council of unit owners or by any other unit owner. The prevailing party in any such proceeding is entitled to an award for counsel fees as determined by court.

This section conforms to Title 11-113 of the Condominium Act. The failure of the council of unit owners (Board of Directors) to enforce a provision of this title, the declaration, or bylaws on any occasion is not a waiver of the right to enforce the provision on any other occasion.

AMENDMENTS OF THE BYLAWS AS APPROVED AT THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF MARYLAND MUTUAL NO. ELEVEN, INC.

WHEREAS, it has ben determined that it is desirable to amend the following articles to the Bylaws of Maryland Mutual No Eleven, Inc., that were approved by the unit owners representing 83.34% of the Membership:

Maryland Legislature in 1998 enacted, and the Governor signed, <u>Senate Bill 18</u> (Meetings and Distribution of Written Material), <u>Senate Bill 94</u> (No Impact, Home Based Business), and <u>House Bill 36</u> (Display of Signs) which affect Leisure World and require changes in Mutual 11 By-Laws.

AMEND ARTICLE IV, SECTION 1, by adding the following sentence:

"In addition, unit owners may meet to discuss matters relating to the condominium at any facility used by the Board of Directors for scheduled meetings. Owners are also permitted to distribute written material regarding the operation of the condominium in any manner used by the Board of Directors, except that door-to-door distribution is prohibited."

AND, SECTION 2, by inserting the date of the Annual Meeting as follows: in the first sentence after "held on" insert "the third Wednesday of April."

AMEND ARTICLE X by inserting after Section 4 the following new section:


